

Notice of Conclusion of Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations Representation of the People Act 1983

Rushcliffe Borough Council has completed a review of polling districts and polling places in accordance with the Representation of the People Act 1983.

The Council has taken into account public comments, observations and representations in reaching its decisions, and has now published a final list of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations that will come into force when the revised register is published on 1st January 2025.

- All representations made by any person in connection with the review.
- Correspondence sent to any person or consultee to whom the authority contacted because they had particular expertise in relation to access to premises or facilities for disabled people

Following the conclusion of the local authority's review certain persons have a right to make representations to the Electoral Commission.

The Commission will only consider representations that the review process has not been conducted correctly and has failed to meet the reasonable requirements of the electors in the constituency or has failed to take sufficient account of accessibility to disabled persons of the polling stations within a polling place.
