

## **The Counter Terrorism Local Priorities for 2024/25 in Nottinghamshire are:**

1. AQ/ISIS Inspired Terrorism
2. Extreme Right-Wing Terrorism
3. Online Extremism
4. Self-Initiated Terrorists (S-ITs).

OFFICIAL Referrals into Nottinghamshire Prevent have increased by 2% on the previous year. Education provided most of these referrals (37% in total), closely followed by policing.

The highest number of referrals were received from Nottingham City. In 56% of referrals there was no ideology established.

### **Locally Identified Threats**

The Nottinghamshire CTLP does not indicate any risks associated with Rushcliffe Borough Council area but identifies general priorities.

### **In Conclusion**

This risk assessment does not indicate any areas of additional concern and known threats are **low**.
