The Counter Terrorism Local Priorities for 2024/25 in Nottinghamshire are:

- 1. AQ/ISIS Inspired Terrorism
- 2. Extreme Right-Wing Terrorism
- 3. Online Extremism
- 4. Self-Initiated Terrorists (S-ITs).

OFFICIAL Referrals into Nottinghamshire Prevent have increased by 2% on the previous year. Education provided most of these referrals (37% in total), closely followed by policing.

The highest number of referrals were received from Nottingham City. In 56% of referrals there was no ideology established.

Locally Identified Threats

The Nottinghamshire CTLP does not indicate any risks associated with Rushcliffe Borough Council area but identifies general priorities.

In Conclusion

This risk assessment does not indicate any areas of additional concern and known threats are **low**.
